



LA HABRA CITY LITTLE LEAGUE FIELD PROCEDURES/GAMES & PRACTICES

1. Players, managers, coaches, team mom's and team dad's, umpires or spectators with symptoms of fever, cough, or worsening respiratory symptoms, or any known exposure to a person with COVID-19 in the prior 14 days will not be allowed on the field.
2. The temperature of managers, coaches, team moms and team dads, scorekeepers, umpires and players are to be taken prior to entering the field. Any person with a temperature of 100.4 °F and above will not be allowed to enter the field.
3. Managers, coaches, team moms, team dads, parents, scorekeepers, umpires and players must bring their own hand sanitizer and cloth face covering to the game. Anyone, upon entering the field, shall use hand sanitizer.
4. Players must bring their own chairs which are to be put in a designated area (six feet apart) to sit on while waiting to hit or when not on the field. Cloth face coverings must be worn. Dugouts are not to be used during practice.
5. Only one hitter and one coach are allowed in a batting cage at a time. Players/Coaches waiting their turn to hit the batting cage **MUST** be spaced six feet apart and **MUST wear a face mask**.
6. Player bags must be placed six feet apart on the fence or under their chair during practices/games. **Gear bags will not be allowed in the dugout.**
7. Player gear that is not being used must be immediately returned to the player's bag.
8. Players, managers/coaches, and umpires must bring their own personal drinks to ALL team activities. Drinks should be clearly and visibly labeled with the player's name, team and need to be stored in their bags when not being used. Drinks cannot be shared and no birdies. Note: Drinking fountains are off limits. **DO NOT** drink exclusively from them,.
9. Managers and players must sanitize their hands before and after playing catch and any other drills.
10. When running a lap, players **MUST** remain ten feet apart.
11. During games, managers, players, and umpires must sanitize their hands at the start of the top half and the start of the bottom half of every inning. If they have forgotten. If they did forget their own hand sanitizer either the Manager
12. To limit contact between teams, there should be one set of **4 fairly "NEW" baseballs for the top half of innings, and another fairly new set of 4 (new or slightly used) baseballs for the bottom half of innings for games. Each set must be wiped with the league disinfectant wipes after each half inning.**
13. Umpires should limit their contact with the ball and ALL Players at practices.
Catchers are to retrieve foul balls and passed balls at field practices.
14. Balls used in infield/outfield warm-up should be isolated from a shared ball container and **MUST** be wiped before.
15. No spectators should retrieve balls landing outside the field of play. Balls can be wiped with a disinfectant wipe prior to being put back in play.
16. Equipment sharing should be avoided, or minimized, when feasible.
17. Only managers and umpires will attend pregame meetings. Social distancing and cloth face coverings are required.
18. During team discussions, players, managers, and coaches must be six feet apart and wear cloth face coverings. At the end of practice, team discussions must be completed before the next team comes onto the field.
19. The umpire must stay six feet away from players. Umpires are **STRONGLY** encouraged to wear cloth face coverings, especially when umpiring behind the mound.
20. No handshakes, fist bumps or physical contact celebration is allowed.
21. During a game, only the on-deck batter can be in the dugout in all divisions.
22. Teams cannot share any snacks or food. No (sunflower seeds), seeds of any kind, gum or spitting/chewing allowed or tossed.
23. Managers and Coaches must sanitize their hands before and after setting up or taking down the field.
24. No after game/practice discussions. Players must leave the field immediately.
25. Spectators at games must watch from beyond the outfield fence. It is recommended that they wear a cloth face covering & stay six feet apart from other family groups. Spectators at practice may only watch from their vehicles.
26. Spectators who are wishing to attend (and those who were tested prior at the age of 65 years or older), are strongly encouraged to not stay at the field and watch the game.
