



2020 La Habra City Little League Safe to Play Code of Conduct



As a La Habra City Little League Baseball player, to protect my fellow players, teammates, and coaches from getting sick, I will...



1. Stay home from practices or games if I am feeling sick or have been exposed to someone sick.
2. Bring the following for my personal use only and show them to my coach at every practice and game:
 - Face covering (labeled with my name and worn on arrival & departure from fields and as recommended by state and local governments)
 - Hand sanitizer
 - Folding chair
3. Bring drinks in containers that are clearly and visibly labeled with my name.
4. Refrain from sharing drinks including birdies.
5. Have my temperature taken prior to entering the field for practices & games. If I have a fever (100.4 °F or higher), I will be unable to participate in practice or play in the game. I will be sent home.
6. Maintain six feet between myself and others whenever possible.
7. Remain in the field until the practice or game ends except to use the restroom.
8. Refrain from eating any type of seeds, nuts with shells, or chewing gum at the park.
9. Refrain from spitting.
10. Use only my equipment and not share equipment with other players or touch their things.
11. Hang my bag/place my bag under my chair in the designated locations 6 feet apart from others.
12. Keep my equipment and other items in my personal bag when not in use.
13. Tip my hat to teammates and opponents instead of giving high fives, fist bumps, and elbow bumps at the end of the game and immediately leave the field. There will be no after game meetings.

In addition to the above code of conduct, I will abide by the following and the most current La Habra City Little League Best Practices on Organizing, Playing, and Watching Little League Baseball During the Coronavirus Pandemic guidelines.

14. A spectator with any of the following conditions must not attend a practice or game: fever, cough, active COVID-19 infection, or known direct contact with an individual testing positive for COVID-19.
15. Spectators may watch practice from their vehicle but must not watch practice on the field or park. Spectators may watch games from the areas behind the outfield fence, bringing their own chairs, and following social distancing practices. Spectators must stay clear of the player seating area and avoid direct hand or other contact with players, managers, coaches, and balls leaving the field of play.
16. Except for a parent with a child, a "one-in-one-out" policy will apply to the use of the restroom, where only one individual is permitted within the restroom at one time to ensure adequate distancing.
